Aquatain AMF Officially Exempted from Registration in the European Union

In conjunction with our European partner and licensees Bleu Line - B.L. GROUP and its production plant Selecta – B.L. GROUP, we are delighted to announce that Aquatain AMF liquid mosquito film has been formally exempted from registration as a biocide in all European Union. This is a landmark event in the development of the product globally.

Aquatain AMF is a silicone based liquid which spreads across the surface of standing water, forming a very thin film. The low surface tension of the film prevents mosquito larvae and pupae from attaching at the surface to take the proper oxygen from the atmosphere to survive, thereby causing them to drown. The product does not contain any toxic chemicals. As silicones are inert, the film remains intact for around 4 weeks.

The European Commission has accepted that the action of Aquatain AMF is purely physical, and therefore it does not fall within the EU definition of a biocide.

The efficacy and safety of the product have been demonstrated in many, many independent trials around the world and, as such, it's the first mainstream mosquito control product which has been exempted from registration in the EU.

With the EU exemption, and also the recent official approval in Hong Kong, the product is now approved for sale in more than 50 countries across all continents.
